Gas Malaysia, Wasco Greenergy study biomass steam systems for industrial use

KUCHING: Gas Malaysia Berhad (Gas Malaysia) and Wasco Greenergy Berhad (Wasco Greenergy) have signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) to conduct a joint feasibility study on biomass-fired steam systems for industrial applications in Peninsular Malaysia, as manufacturers assess lower-carbon energy alternatives.

The study will evaluate the viability of on-site and centralised biomass steam systems, including hybrid configurations combining

biomass and natural gas, with the aim of improving cost efficiency and supporting industrial decarbonisation efforts.

The assessment will cover industrial demand, feedstock supply readiness, project locations, project configurations and business models for potential deployment.

President and group chief executive officer of Gas Malaysia, Azli Mohamed, said industrial customers were increasingly looking for energy solutions that could

balance reliability, cost and sustainability.

"This partnership enables us to evaluate how biomass can complement our existing offerings while supporting Malaysia's energy transition agenda," he said.

Under the collaboration, both parties will explore biomass-based steam solutions by combining their commercial, infrastructure and technical capabilities to determine practical deployment strategies for industrial users.
